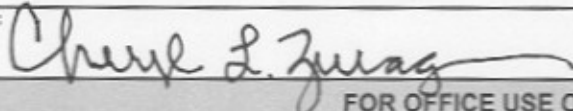

Mining Narrative

DeWent Gravel Corporation is requesting the approval to remove sand and gravel from the above referenced parcels. No processing or screening is proposed on this site.

The DeWent property is located at the North end of Marcan Avenue directly North of the Georgetown Industrial Plat, and East of the Cedar Grove Condominiums. The DeWent property consists of 23.5 Acres of which 6.6 Acres will be mined. The majority of the property was previously mined. The excavation will be done in anticipation of the improvements required to develop this property for a proposed industrial park, similar to the adjacent properties to the South and East. The two lots east of the DeWent property are also being included within the mining proposal in order to remove the soil along the common property line.

Based on estimates provided by Exxel Engineering, there will be approximately 145,000 cubic yards of material excavated out of the 6.6 Acres. Approximately half of the material will be used on the site for the proposed development. The excess material will be removed from the site. The excess material will be approximately 80,000 cubic yards of material.

It is anticipated that the material will be removed from the site over the next 2-3 years as DeWent Gravel Corporation moves the soil on the site to create the elevations needed for the proposed development. A new access drive will be constructed off the existing Marcan Ave. This new drive will run 300 ft into the property to service the proposed mining and will be the designated truck route.

Excess material will be hauled off-site by trucks to the DeWent Gravel Corporation processing plant. The proposed trucking route will travel South on Marcan Ave., East on Wilshere Dr., North on Roger Dr., East on Pine Ridge Dr., North on 18th Ave., and East on DeWent Dr. to the processing plant. This route is approximately 1.0 mile.

Hours of operation will be 7:00am to 6:00pm Monday – Friday and 8:00am to 3:00pm on Saturdays. NO Sundays or Holidays.

All operations will be maintained in a neat and orderly fashion. Proper measures will be taken to minimize the noise levels and dust from the operations. The existing 6 ft. chain-link fence (with wire) will be maintained as practical throughout the mining process.

The equipment to be used on-site will be a loader, dozer and dump trucks for transporting the soil to the processing site. The equipment will be stored within the existing pole building during evenings and weekends.

Screening along the westerly residential property is accomplished by the existing 6 ft. berm, 6 ft. board fence and evergreen plantings along the property line. Screening along the Northern residential property is accomplished by the following:

- Existing vegetation along the property line and within the 50 ft. setback.
- Proposed 6 ft. berm along the mining cut area
- 40 ft +/- elevation differential

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
