Subject: Biosolids Application Notification

The City of Grandville, Michigan has contracted with SYNAGRO MIDWEST to apply Biosolids from the City's Wastewater Treatment Plant to farmland in your area. Application to agricultural fields provides for the recycling of nutrients (i.e. Nitrogen, Phosphorus and Potassium) contained in the Biosolids at no cost to the grower. The City of Grandville is one of many Wastewater Plants throughout Michigan that is providing this benefit to farmers. This beneficial use program is part of a larger, national recycling effort to return nutrients back to nature in a controlled manner. Enacted into law in November 1999, Michigan Part 24 Biosolids Rules set specific parameters for the treatment of Biosolids and their subsequent application to land.

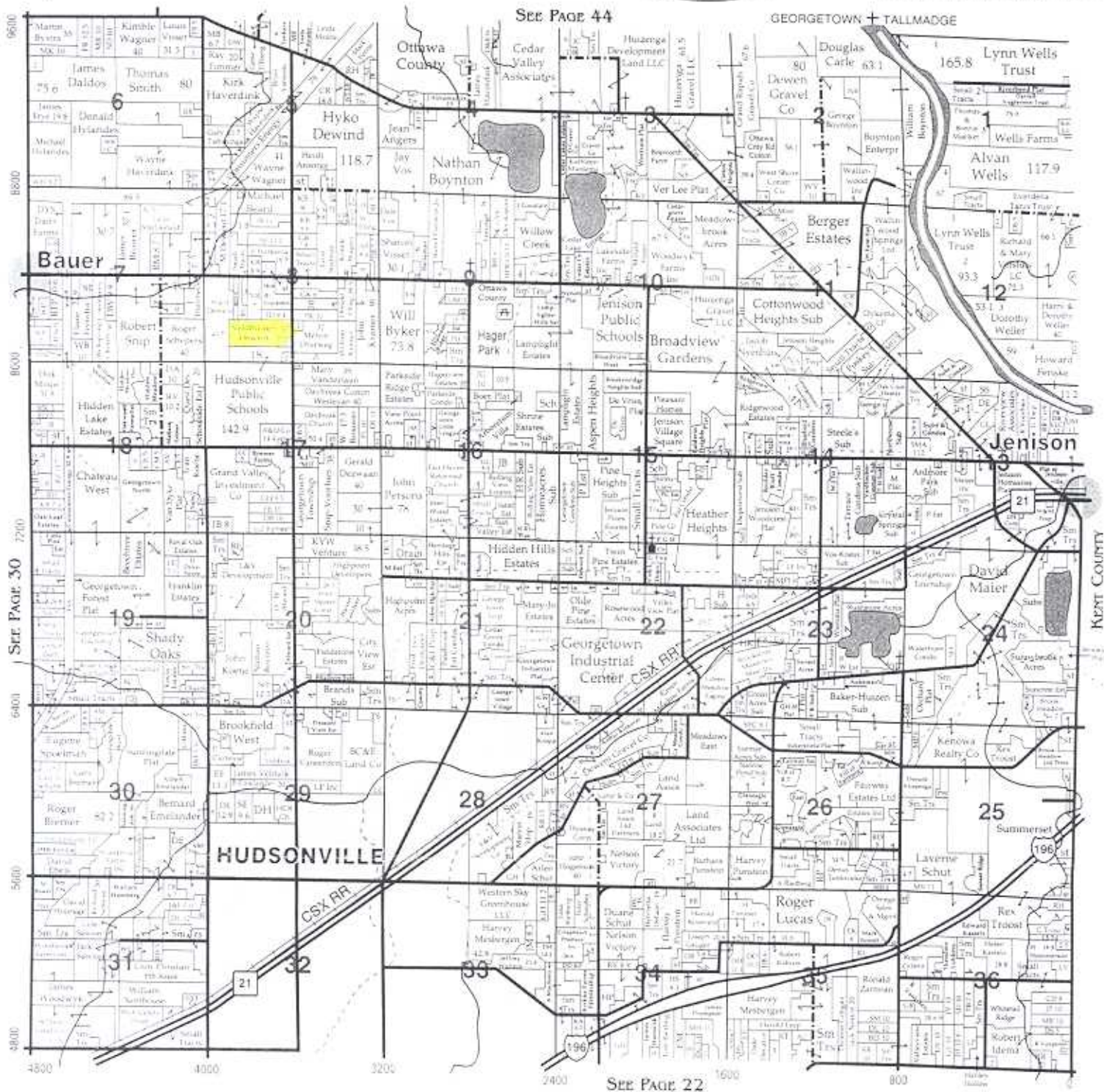
