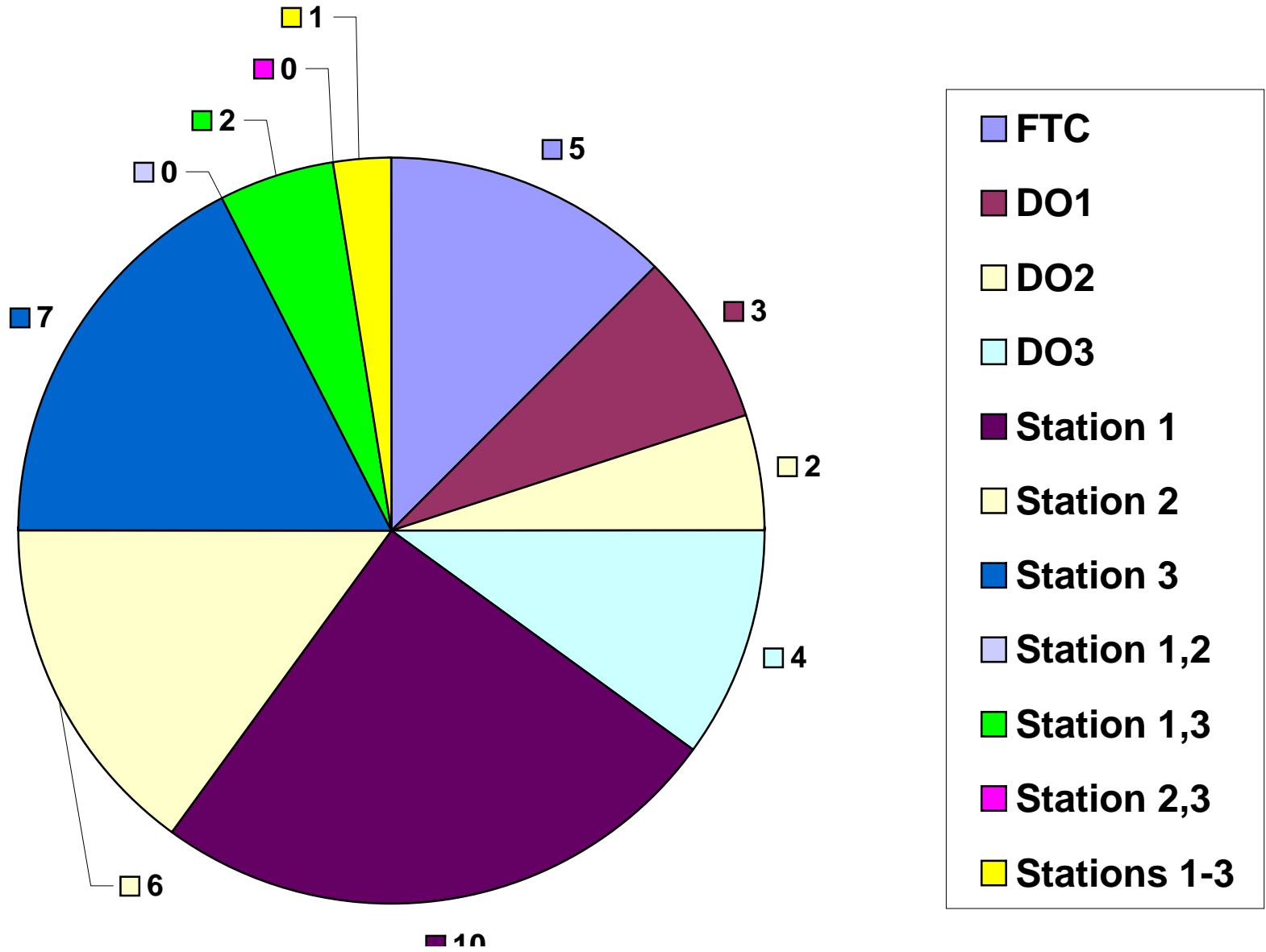
The Georgetown Township Fire Department responded to a total of 40 runs for the month of April 2005, with an average response time of 7.02.

- Attended the Tri-County Fire Inspectors Association meeting on Tuesday the 19th held at Plainfield Twp. Fire Station 3.

Fire Investigation and Follow Up

- 7062 – 12th Ave. – Vehicle fire investigation.
- 1034 Meadow Lane – follow up on an unattended recreational fire that was extinguished by Station 1.
- 9086 Cottonwood – follow up on an unattended leaf fire that was extinguished by Station 2.
- 1324 Port Sheldon – follow up on an unattended recreational fire that was extinguished by Station 1.

Fire Investigation and Follow Up cont.

- 2471 Wilshere, Sunset Waste – Deliver letter to Jim Daling in reference to their false alarm problem and that it had to be taken care of within a week. Received confirmation back from the alarm company that it was taken care of within two days.

- Check out the Van Buren road closure between 16th Ave and 22nd Ave.
- Post sign-up sheets in the station for the upcoming “Kids Day America” event coming up in May to be held at the Soccer Zone.
- Met with Fire Pros at the Township Offices to get them started on the annual fire alarm testing.
- Assisted Matt with getting a car to Station 3 for extrication training.
- Make copies of the open burning ordinance for Station 2.
- Distribute the 911 Emergency Contact sheet to local businesses.
- Check out brush pile at 6041-36th Ave., AAA Turf, to be burnt.
- Met with Captain DeWitt to go over apparatus placement at 23 Baldwin for the house burn.
- Met with Loren Serne, PCI Electrical Inspector, Brad Petersen from Kelley Slentz Electric, Inc., and Matt DeWitt to go through the SBC building at 2820 Port Sheldon. Brad went over the new fire alarm system that they installed and then we tested it for proper operation.
- 10th Ave. & Vos - followed up on a citizen complaint of a neighbor burning leaves and garbage. Everything checked out ok.
