1. Call to order by R. J. Poel, Chair at 7:30 AM

4. Moved by South, Supported by Poel to approve the minutes of May 16th, 2005
5. Inspector Kennedy reported that jons at 8th and Maplewood Parks should be barrier free, to comply with standards. Rod, Parks Director was going to put barrier jons in place as soon as possible.
6. Sgt Ward presented information about High Speed Chase Spikes. There use and effectiveness. Committee question about Ottawa Counties Policy on a Chase and the liability. It was suggested that the Road Supervisor have this devise and it could be used county wide. Also committee was concerned about the devise in each Georgetown vehicle could at any time leave the Township to be used County wide at the Township expense. Sgt Ward said that would not happen. Sgt Ward recommended that each of the County units assigned the Township carry the devise. 9 units at \$340.00 each. Total \$3060.00. Sgt Ward to report at a later time.
7. Sgt Ward reported on paramedic training. Suggested that that be taught in house. Saving about \$9000.00 County Emergency Services will receive training equipment for this program to be shared with the Fire Department. Manikins and the like programmed for all types of chemical spills.
8. The dive team was recognized for their efforts in the recovery of the drowning victim in Wyoming last week. The Chief reported that there was a debriefing for the Fire Dept Dive Team. Responding to request for the dive equipment is part of the County Mutual Aid

agreement.
