Fire Investigation and Follow Up

- 7859 West Side Drive – Investigate fire in wood chip bed in the front of the residence.
- 3152 Port Sheldon – Follow up on repeated false alarms at this facility.

Other

- Wrote the July activity month end report for Inspectors Activity and Fire Prevention Bureau and e-mailed them to the Chief.
- Checked out the large column of black smoke to the west side of the township and found it to be in Blendon Township. Advised Deputy Chief Kurt Gernaat of it and he had the contractor extinguish the fire.

- Ran HT-1000 batteries through the conditioner for Lt. DeWindt.
- Daily check on the 8th Ave. and Kenowa Ave. road closures.
- Met with Chief Hamming and Captain McIntyre at Township Offices to go over the new Touch-N-Track accountability system.
- Bring Engine 822 to the auction at Hudsonville Fair Grounds with Matty.
- Log the photos from 62 Mill Street.
- Inventory Fire Prevention material and order the books we'll need for this year from National Fire Safety Council.
- Code research on dumpster location next to structures.
- Deliver material to Stations 1 & 2 for Deputy Chief Poolman.
- Met with Chief Hamming ref. the new fire access lane for Serviscreens new building.
- Met with Steve Witte, Nederveld & Associates, ref. the new fire access lane for Serviscreens new building.
