- Attend the Tri-County Fire Inspectors all day training at Plainfield Township on November 8. Subject was Fire Walls and Fire Rated Separation (Maximum Foreseeable Loss Walls).

- Met with Dick Kennedy to go over Property Maintenance Code requirements for 1 & 2 Family Dwellings.
- Assisted Fire Inspector Bill Aman, Wyoming F. D., with the NFPA 13 requirements for air compressors on a dry pipe sprinkler system.
- Worked with Chief Hamming on payroll issues.

- Chief Hamming, Dick Kennedy, and I met with PCI to go over the issues we had with an individual renting the basement area of a single family dwelling as his permanent residence.
- Met with Jay Hinzman at United Rentals to go over the LP Gas code for their proposed LP Gas Tank installation.
- Captain McIntyre and I talked to the 3rd grade class at Bursley Elementary the afternoon of November 2.
- Chief Hamming, Captain McIntyre, and I met to go over personnel issues.
- File the October month end report with the fire chief's office for the Fire Inspectors Activity and the Fire Prevention Bureau.
- Met with Brett Pawloski from A & B Fire Protection to go over his certifications to do fire protection work.
- Met with the manager at Kuperus Trucking to put their master key in the newly installed Knox Box.
- Update Knox Box list and distribute them to the stations.
- Generated a letter on the compromised exit access hallway at 7500 Cottonwood. This letter was sent to the four store managers occupying space at this address and also to the building owner.
- Met with Jay Hinzman at United Rental to verify his questions on whether their 500 gallons diesel tank storage area was code compliant or not.
- Performed the final fire alarm test at Fellowship Reformed Church on November 7 with PCI, Chief Hamming, and F.F. Matt DeWitt.
- Updated the 16 volume NFPA Code set.
- Met with the manager of Eagle Brook Apartments to discuss the fire alarm problems they are having and also the issue of cars parked on the main roadways in the complex. We had an issue of not being able to get the aerial truck in the complex.
- Plan Review – Cottonwood Heights Christian Reformed Church, 1101 Cypress. Canopy addition to church and construction of new youth building.
- Plan Review – Meijer, 550 Baldwin. Addition to the east side of building.
- Met Chuck Dyk (PCI) and Chief Hamming at 6373 Clover Lane to conduct a follow-up inspection with the individual renting the basement for his living quarters.
- Reviewed Sunset Manors "Policy and Procedures For Fire Emergencies" with Chief Hamming. Chief Hamming and I have been requested to meet with their safety committee in December.

Monthly Activity Report

November 2005

2nd – Captain Tim McIntyre and I presented a fire safety message to the 3rd grade classes at Bursley Elementary. We showed the class our video on “Get Out Alive” and then discussed with the class on what they saw and the dos and don’ts that the narrator talked about. We then took the classes out to Aerial Truck and showed the students all the equipment that fire fighters use at fire scenes. We had a total of 52 students and 2 teachers in attendance.

21st – Lt. Gary Danielson and F. F. Tom Datema presented a fire safety talk and station tour to a group of Jenison Tiger Cubs. On special events like this the scout leaders have their parents along as chaperons. This in turn gives us the opportunity to present our fire safety message to the adults also. There were 14 Tiger Cubs and 11 adults in attendance.
