- Attended the Tri County Fire Inspectors monthly educational seminar held at the EPS, 750 Front, on December 13. The morning session was on "Fire Alarm Systems" presented by Mr. Tom Presnak from UL Laboratories. The afternoon session was on "Fire Department Site Requirements" presented by Fire Marshal Marty Myers, City of Kalamazoo.
