Education

- Attended the December meeting of the Tri-County Fire Inspectors meeting held on December 12 at Georgetown Station 3. The State of Michigan representative went over changes in the BCCFS to Bureau of Fire Services, changes in Michigan Fire Prevention Code, Public Act 207 of 1941 and Enforcement and Administration of the Michigan Fire Prevention Code, Public Act 207.

Fire Investigation and Follow Up

- Investigated the origin and cause of the house fire in Jamestown Twp. at 2321 Riley Street. Wrote up the report and filed it with the photo's.

Other

- Attend the monthly meeting with Chief Hamming and F. F. Matt DeWitt.
- Finish updating the map books for the three stations.
- Reviewed information received on new fire door hold open device for Georgetown C.R.C.
- Picked up FIT testing equipment from Station 2 and brought it over to Station 1 where Spectrum Health will perform FIT Testing for the department personnel.
- Updated Fire Run Quadrant 823 per Chief Hamming and faxed to Dave Fontaine at Central Dispatch. Changes were made in the dispatch computer system and this office for our records received copies.
- Checked out a call I received via TX about wires arcing by Tanis Trucking. I talked with the mechanic at Tanis and he had just called Consumers to come out and look at the wires. The wires that did arc did trip the breaker on the power pole in front of the business.
- Researched NFPA 13, Installation of Sprinkler Systems, with Chief Mel VanRhee from Jamestown. He was having an issue with an architect and needed a little assistance.
- Researched the codes to see if existing buildings with existing fire alarm systems are required to have inside notification (horns, strobes, or horn/strobes) for the tenants.
- Worked on more updates for our Resource Books that we carry in all the fire department vehicles.
- Met with Chief Hamming for my yearly employee evaluation.
- Attend the annual Township Employee Christmas luncheon.
- Filed inspection reports received from Fire Pros Inc. and sent out follow-up letter to one of our local businesses on the deficiency noted from one of their inspections.
- Researched NFPA 13 for the requirements of pressure testing underground water main for fire protection systems.
- Followed up on a request from Chief Hamming to go out Crystal Creek Church at 5151 – 8th Ave. and call Central Dispatch to see what name and address showed on their computer when I called. When this was done the address of 5151 – 8th Ave. Crystal Creek Church was what showed on Central's computer screen. Seems there was a discrepancy with address numbering at the Township Office.
- Research NFPA 14 for the installation requirements of fire department standpipe hose valves.

- Met with Karen Koster, custodian at Georgetown Bible Church. She had the master keys for the church to be locked up in their newly installed Knox Box.
- Updated the Knox Box Listing and distributed copies to the stations.
