- Tuesday the 20th – Attended the Tri-County Fire Inspectors training on Special Amusement Occupancies. This was held at the Double “J” Ranch in Rothbury.

Fire Investigation and Follow Up

- Monday the 19th – Investigated the vehicle and house fire at 3510 Bauer Road with Joel DeKraker, the cause and origin investigator hired by Liberty Mutual Insurance Company.
- Thursday the 22nd – Investigated the cause of the kitchen fire at 2816 Hunters Drive.
- Wednesday the 28th – Investigated the cause of the dishwasher fire at 7457 Russell Drive.

Other

- Record and email Februarys month end reports to Chief Hamming.
- Brought Engine 821 to HME to check out the electrical problems that occurred on a fire run.
- Met with Chief Hamming and Captain McIntyre at Station 1 to go over response guidelines for this station.
- Met with Chief Hamming, Denny Bishop and Robb Lamer from Exxel Engineering to go over the water main and fire hydrant layout for the new commercial development going in on the northwest corner of 36th Ave. and Baldwin Street for Baldwin Georgetown LLC.
- Went around and checked out our apartment complexes for buried fire hydrants. Advised Eaglebrook complex manager to get their hydrants dug out right away. Was called the next day and their snowplow contractor had them all dug out and available for our use. The other complexes had their hydrants dug out and available for use.
- Conducted a fire alarm test with PCI and ADT at Cottonwood Veterinary Center, 7666 Cottonwood Drive.
- Attended the monthly staff meeting with Chief Hamming and F. F. Matt DeWitt.
- Put together a map book and resource book for Lt. Ross Tibbets.
- Plan Review – (PUD0604-01) Final Development Plan for Phase 1 for Baldwin Georgetown LLC, 7665 – 36th Ave.
- Plan Review – (ST0705) Campus View Office – 10295 – 42nd Ave.
- Met with Doug Stalsonburg, from Exxel Engineering, to review the site plan for Campus View Office addition and go over the fire hydrant locations and were the fire department would be requiring an additional one.
- Met with John Scholma from Georgetown CRC to review the plan for adding internal walls to create more storage rooms.

- Wrote a letter of concern to Mr. Burt Jones, State Fire Inspector, reference concerns about the conditions encountered at the Barry AFC Home.
- Followed up on a phone call Chief Hamming received about a builder burning building scraps at his construction site.
- Researched the fire codes sprinkler head obstructions. Particularly with walk-in coolers and freezers. Contacted NFPA Technical Department and received a reply on this issue.

Monthly Activity Report

March 2007

22nd – Today we had 8 preschoolers along with their mothers come to Station 3 for a tour of the fire station and look at all the equipment on the fire truck. We also had them sit up in the fire truck and had their pictures taken in the seats where the fire fighters sit. We then put on our protective fire gear to show the kids what a fire fighter looks like when they go into a house to fight the fire.

26th – Today we went to the Horizon Center Preschool. Since it was a great spring day with temperatures in the 70's we took the kids outside and showed them all the equipment on the fire engine. We quizzed them on the different tools and asked them if they knew what we would use them for. We then had them all sit inside the engine and had them strap in and pretend that they were fire fighters ready to go to a fire. Afterwards we went inside and had a little question and answer time and then gave them fire helmets and goody bags with coloring books and safety pamphlets for their parents. We had two classes totaling 17 kids and 4 teachers attending this event.
