Other

- Email March's monthly activity reports to Chief Hamming.
- Collect the stations month end payroll reports and drop them off to Jill.
- Checked out the exact addresses on Elizabeth Lane East and West for Dave Fontaine, Central Dispatch Records Technician.
- Checked out the storage buildings in the 900 block of Rosewood for someone using one of the spaces for manufacturing. The township received a complaint from a citizen that someone had moved some machinery into one of those storage units and set up shop. At this time there is no indication of this being done.
- Met with Pleune Service Company at Station 1 for the repair of the station bay heaters.
- Put fire prevention information packets for the upcoming student tours at station 3.
- Fill a SCBA bottle from Engine 825.
- Met with Al Davignon, Grand Rapids Gravel Company, at the Taylor Street gravel pit to go over the requirements for the location of the fire extinguisher at their fleet fuel tank site.
- Met the Air Source One mechanic at station 1. He was here to replace the control valves on the breathing air refilling station.
- Took Engine 825 to Action Collision to have the drivers door window replaced.
- Took Engine 821 to HME to have the defective ignition switch replaced.
- Followed up on a burning complaint at 1010 Vos Street that was reported to Dick Kennedy.
- Followed up on a burning complaint at 7275-12th Ave that Chief Hamming received at the office.
- Researched the codes for Loren Serne in reference to the fire alarm monitoring requirements for existing buildings that add on to their existing fire sprinkler system.
- Contacted the State Fire Inspector about combustible storage being stored in the furnace area above the kitchen at Bursley Elementary that I received from a concerned citizen. The State Fire Inspector asked me to take care of it for him. I met with Tim and Orlando, maintenance personnel for Jenison Public Schools, at Bursley and went up into that area. Checking with the code requirements and what type of AHU's were up there, the storage of combustible material is allowed up there due to the type of building construction and the type of AHU's. These findings were forwarded on to the State Fire Inspector.
- Followed up on a citizen complaint about trees and shrubs overgrowing the front of the house at 848 Port Sheldon. The citizen was concerned that if there were a fire at this house we wouldn't have access to the front door to gain entry.

12th – This afternoon we had 10 Girl Scouts with their leaders stop by Station 3 for a tour of the station. We showed them all the types of tools that we carry on the truck that fire fighters use on the job. We also had them put on our fire gear so they could tell how heavy it is. We demonstrated the use of the thermal imaging camera and then had them use it as if they were looking for a fire. Also everyone had a turn to sitting in the seats of the cab where the fire fighters sit while enroute to a fire. Afterwards we handed out packets of fire safety information for them and their parents.
