How to Participate

1. Pick up a bingo form between June 11 & August 1 at the Georgetown Township Public Library.
2. Read books as designated in the bingo boxes. Materials do not have to be checked out from the Georgetown Township Public Library. Print books, audiobooks, e-books, and e-audiobooks are all acceptable formats.
3. Mark off a bingo square each time you complete a book.
4. For each bingo you finish, bring in your booklet to receive a prize with a maximum of 3 bingos per person. A bingo consists of 5 squares in a row horizontally, vertically, or diagonally.
5. Along with completing the bingo sheet, each book you read may be entered into a weekly drawing. Every time you finish a book, come to the library to fill out a drawing slip to be entered into the weekly drawing for gift cards to places around the community.
6. Keep an eye out for pop-up contests throughout the summer!
7. All bingo sheets and drawing slips must be completed and turned in by August 3, 2018.

Explanation of Genres

Biography: a detailed description of a person's life

Book Into Movie: a book that has been turned into a movie

Chick-Lit: tells a story of the personal growth of one or more women

Civil War Era: takes place during the Civil War

Classic: noted as having outstanding and enduring qualities

Dystopian Fiction: explores the illusion of a perfect society through social and political control

First Book of a Series: a book that is first in a series

Historical Fiction: the plot takes place in the past

Inspirational Fiction: highlights characters overcoming adversity; a book that uplifts and entertains the reader

Juvenile Fiction: aimed towards readers ages 8-12; please read two books to fulfill this goal

Medical Fiction: centered on a medical environment

Michigan Author: a book by an author from Michigan

Mystery: a book involving a crime to be solved

Non-Fiction: a book that is true; based on facts

Poetry Anthology: a collection of poems

Regency Fiction: a book set in the regency era (1811-1820)

Science Fiction or Fantasy: speculative fiction that takes place in worlds that are not real

Sports Fiction: centered on a sport or sports-related theme

Western: set in the American Old West frontier

Young Adult Fiction: a book that is aimed at teen readers
