Releasor understands and acknowledges the significance and consequence of the specific intention to release all claims and assumes full responsibility of any injuries, damages, or losses that it may have or may incur from performance of or in connection with this contract and agrees to hold harmless and indemnify Ottawa Impact and Georgetown Township from any and all claims, injuries and damages arising from or in connection with participation in the Jenison Memorial Day Parade or any way in connection with the Agreement. Ottawa Impact and Georgetown Township damages include not only actual damages, but also reasonable attorney fees incurred by Ottawa Impact and Georgetown Township in defense of such claims, damages or actions.
